Construction Activities - see below map

- The project area (in blue) is located on the north bank of the American River running from Howe Avenue east to the Kadema Drive access ramp. Crews will be raising the levee height between 0.5 to 1.5 feet for a distance of approximately 4,200 linear feet, and improving the waterside levee slope to Corps standards.
- The truck/equipment haul route (in red) will be a clockwise loop with trucks travelling from American River Drive and entering the project area via the Kadema Drive access ramp.
- Construction hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday, and from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Sundays. The project will start on/after July 23, and completion is expected by November 2012.

Access & Detours

- The American River Bike Trail and major thoroughfares will remain open during construction, but the Howe Avenue Bridge trail access and the Kadema Drive trail access will be closed for safety.
