

# **Dear Neighbor,**

## **We're working to reduce your flood risk.**

### **Construction Activities:**

Beginning the week of August 9, 2012, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Sacramento District has scheduled American River levee construction near your residence. (Map on reverse side)

This necessary work is a joint flood-risk reduction effort between the Corps' Sacramento District, the state of California's Central Valley Flood Protection Board and Sacramento Area Flood Control District.

### **Construction Hours:**

Standard construction hours will be 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday and 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Sundays.

However, around mid-September, construction may occur between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. for up to six nights. This night time work is to accommodate the requirements of the power company, so they may lower energy levels in the overhanging lines, allowing construction to occur underneath those lines.

Exact dates will be determined by the power company, Western Area Power Administration.


