

Deer Flat Boat-In Camping


The Deer Flat Campground is located on a large peninsula across the lake from the Fiddleneck Day Use Area and the boat launches.

It is open from May 1st through September 30th, and is the only boat-in camping area on the lake.

The size of the campground will depend upon the water level. However, camping is confined to that portion of the peninsula which is bordered on the east side by a 75 foot fire break and fence.

Camping is limited to 25 feet from the fire ring of your campsite.

Facilities include vault restrooms, fire rings, picnic tables, garbage dumpsters, and a bulletin board.



For your safety and the protection of the resources park rules are enforced at Deer Flat.

All boat-in campers must register at Fiddleneck Entrance Station or the Acorn Campground Entrance Station.

Campsites are \$12.00 per night and are limited to eight people. Two vehicles registered per site and additional vehicles pay \$4.00 per day. Parking is available in the Fiddleneck Day Use Area.

All fires, including BBQ's must be confined to the fire rings. Do not use fire rings to dispose of garbage.

There is no drinking water available at Deer Flat.

All pets must be leashed.
