Paperless Submission Process

- Sacramento District officially went paperless January 1, 2019
- Public Notice on December 27, 2018
- Required all requests to be submitted electronically
- Purpose: Streamline process, be more responsive to the needs of the public and minimize resource use (paper and money).
- Applicable to all requests





Submitting Requests

New requests

 Submit it to our general email inbox at <u>SPKRegulatoryMailbox@usace.army.mil</u> for initial in-processing.

In-process requests (currently assigned to PM)

Submit directly to Project Manager currently assigned to action





Contents of Request

- 1. Preferred file format is a text-recognized.pdf. Word docs in .docx format also acceptable.
 - The Aquatic Resource/Consolidated Upload Excel spreadsheet must be submitted in .xlsm spreadsheet format.
- 2. If transmitting via email, include all information as email attachments, don't transmit info in the body of the email.
- 3. All documents must be submitted as separate files. Do not combine all documents into one Adobe PDF or Word document file.





Contents of Request (cont'n)

- 4. Name files based on their content (i.e. Application, Wetland Delineation, etc.). Please do not use company project numbers or acronyms as the sole basis for the file name(s).
- 5. Reduce file sizes to the maximum extent possible.





Submitting Requests

Multiple options:

- Submit via Email (preferred)
- Upload documents to the Corps S.A.F.E. ftp site
- Send an email with a link to the documents on your company ftp site
- Send CD (no USB flash drives)
- Mail Hardcopy





Email Considerations

- Add County, State, & watershed to the email Subject line.
- The Corps file limit is 10 MB for individual emails
 - ▶ Use .zip files as attachments to compress
 - ▶ Send multiple emails

NOTE: If you must use more than 2 emails to transmit your information, we strongly recommend using the Corps S.A.F.E. ftp site identified below.





S.A.F.E. FTP Site

- Allows non-Corps individuals to initiate file transfer
- File size limitation is 2 GB.
