MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Acceptance of Funds Contributed by Butte County Area of Governments, a Non-Federal Public Entity

1. References:

a. Section 214 of the Water Resources Development Act (WRDA) of 2000 (Public Law 106-541) as amended.

b. Memorandum, CECW, 1 October 2008, Subject: Implementation Guidance for Section 2002 of the Water Resources Act of 2007 (Regulatory Program Funds Contributed by Non-Federal Entities).

2. The sunset clause for Section 214 of WRDA 2000 is 31 December 2016.

3. The purpose of this memorandum is to document my decision to enter into an agreement to accept and expend funds contributed by the Butte County Area of Governments, a non-Federal public entity, to expedite evaluation of permit applications and processes under consideration of our Regulatory Division in accordance with Reference 1a.

4. Per reference 1b, an initial public notice was circulated on 2 August 2011. One comment was received. Caltrans expressed no concerns with our proposed acceptance of funds.

5. The Regulatory Division recommends acceptance of funds from Butte County Area of Governments.


6. I have carefully considered Butte County Area of Governments request and the recommendation of the Regulatory Division. I have determined that acceptance and expenditure of funds from Butte County Area of Governments will not adversely impact impartial decision-making with respect to regulatory permit applications, either substantively or procedurally. The funding program will better serve the public interest through more cost-effective processing of permit applications, enhanced evaluation capability, and a streamlined permit processing system. Our capacity to evaluate permit applications from applicants not party to this funding agreement will not be adversely affected. Accordingly, I find that acceptance and expenditure of funds from Butte County Area of Governments is appropriate and is in accordance with the provisions of Section 214 of WRDA 2000.
