This letter conveys the Sunrise Island Reclamation District's intent to participate in feasibility studies and/or actions in the development of our proposed project as the non-Federal sponsor consistent with the CALFED Bay-Delta Authorization Act (Public Law 108-361).

The Sunrise Island Reclamation District understands that the type, cost, and scope of actions will be determined and specified later if selected for development and or implementation pursuant to the Act.
