Corps Continues to Enforce Safety Closure at Trimmer Marina

PIEDRA, CALIFORNIA (August 26, 2008): The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers announces the continued closure of the Trimmer Marina at Pine Flat Lake due to safety violations.

Pedestrian access continues to be suspended on walkways at the marina due to weaknesses in the decking infrastructure. Access to privately owned vessels may be accomplished by making arrangements with the marina owner and operator, Adrian Spence, at: 559-320-5797. Owners may arrange for private conveyance to their vessels by water only.

Boat owners are only permitted access to their vessels in order to remove them from their slip. Once a boat is removed it cannot return until the marina owner makes repairs in accordance with the lease agreement and safety regulations.

The marina owner has until 26 September 2008 to comply with this notice. Boats not in use may remain at their slip during this timeframe; however, once a boat is accessed it must leave the marina until the repairs are complete and written notice is issued by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' primary concern is public safety and apologizes for any inconvenience the non-compliance of this marina causes individual boat owners.

THE MARINA WILL REMAINED CLOSED AND ACCESS RESTRICTED UNTIL WRITTEN NOTICE IS ISSUED BY THE U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS THAT THE FACILITY CAN BE REOPENED.
