## **Corps to announce Natomas levee analysis results**

Sacramento, CA (January 14, 2008) – The Army Corps of Engineers will publicly announce the results of the analysis for certification of levees in the Natomas area on January 15, 2008, at 1230 p.m. at Shore Bird Park in the Natomas area in Sacramento. On hand for a briefing and questions will be the Corps of Engineers District Engineer for Sacramento, Corps technical experts, other Corps support personnel and representatives from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).

“This will be an excellent opportunity for us to explain the result of our analysis and what it means for the people of Sacramento,” said Col. Tom Chapman, Sacramento District Engineer for the Corps of Engineers.

Camera crews are asked to set up 15 minutes early.

To get to Shorebird Park from downtown Sacramento, take Route 5 north to Garden Parkway. Take Garden Parkway west for approximately 3 miles. Corps personnel will be on hand on the right side of the road. Look for the Corps of Engineers sign. Parking is available at the site.

The meeting is open to the public and everyone is welcome to attend.
