Proposed Action: Delta Wetlands proposes to divert and store water on two Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta islands (Bacon Island and Webb Tract, or “reservoir islands”) for later discharge for export or to meet outflow or environmental requirements for the San Francisco Bay/Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta estuary; and to divert water seasonally to create and manage wetlands and wildlife habitat on two Delta islands (Bouldin Island and most of Holland Tract, or “habitat islands”).

Location: Contra Costa and San Joaquin Counties, California

Document: This Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) is prepared in compliance with the National Environmental Quality Act (NEPA). The FEIS analyzes the impacts of the proposed project alternatives. The impact areas evaluated include water supply and water project operations; hydrodynamics; water quality; flood control; utilities and highways; fishery resources; vegetation and wetlands; wildlife; land use and agriculture; recreation and visual resources; economic conditions and effects; traffic and navigation; cultural resources; mosquitos and public health; and air quality.
