TYPE OF DETERMINATION: Preliminary Or Approved

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION SUPPORTING NJD (e.g., paragraph 1 - site conditions; paragraphs 2-3 - rationale used to determine NJD, including information reviewed to assess potential navigation or interstate commerce connections; and paragraph 4 - site information on waters of the U.S. occurring onsite): The central N/S swale flows south within a small farm ditch but does not overflow. Also, wetland WS1 receives water from a small farm ditch flowing north, but does not over flow the main body of the wetland located north of the ditch. The wetland swale labeled as WS3 flows directly into a ditch that conveys water to the Sacramento River via the East Drainage Canal and the Natomas Main Drainage Canal. Results from vernal pool fairy shrimp sampling have not been completed, so it is unknown whether they are present on the site. However, burrowing owls were visible within the Panhandle properties during the site visits.
