TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

SUBJECT: The District Engineer, Corps of Engineers, Sacramento District has re-issued Regional General Number GP-031 under authority of Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act and Section 404 of the Clean Water for a period of five years from date of this public notice. The general permit authorizes certain specific discharges of dredged or fill material associated with solar extraction of minerals around the Great Salt Lake in Salt Lake, Tooele, Weber, and Box Elder Counties, and Sevier Lake in Millard County, Utah. The re-issuance of this regional general permit was based upon the evaluation of the potential individual and cumulative impacts of the regulated activities. Comments received in response to a public notice on this proposal were considered in this evaluation. The Sacramento District concluded that the re-issuance of the permit complies with the Environmental Protection Agency Section 404 (b) (1) Guidelines for evaluation discharges of dredged or fill material in waters of the United States, and is not contrary to the public interest. The activities authorized by this permit are similar in nature and similar in their impact upon water quality and the aquatic environment, will have only minimal adverse effects when performed separately, and will have only minimal cumulative adverse effects on water quality and the aquatic environment.
