TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

SUBJECT: The Sacramento District is proposing to extend General Permit 60 for an additional five years. This permit authorizes fill and excavation activities in waters of the United States for repair and protection activities in emergency situations where a state or federal emergency or disaster has been declared. A copy of the permit is attached.

LOCATION: Within the State of Nevada and parts of the State of California, within the Sacramento District's regulatory boundaries.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Corps of Engineers is soliciting comments from the public; Federal, state, and local agencies and officials; Indian Tribes; and other interested parties in order to consider and evaluate the impacts of this proposed activity. Any comments received will be considered by the Corps of Engineers to determine whether to issue, modify, condition or deny a permit for this proposal. To make this decision, comments are used to assess impacts on endangered species, historic properties, water quality, general environmental effects, and the other public interest factors listed above. Comments are used in the preparation of an Environmental Assessment and/or an Environmental Impact Statement pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act. Comments are also used to determine the need for a public hearing and to determine the overall public interest of the proposed activity.
