SUBJECT: On December 12, 2003, the District Engineer, Sacramento District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers issued Public Notice 200250464 advertising his intent to reissue Regional General Permit 40 for the discharge of dredged or fill material in waters of the United States in the state of Utah in those cases in which a stream alteration permit has been issued by the state engineer in compliance with state law. The following information was inadvertently omitted from that public notice:

Certification that the proposed action will not violate applicable water quality standards has been requested from the Utah Division of Water Quality. The Utah Division of Water Quality intends to issue certification, provided the proposed action will not violate applicable water quality standards. Projects are usually certified where the project may create diffuse sources (nonpoint sources) of wastes which will occur only during the actual construction activity and where best management practices will be employed to minimize pollution effects. Written comments on water quality certification for the proposed reissuance of Regional General Permit 40 should be submitted to Mr. William O. Moellmer, Utah Division of Water Quality, 288 North 1460 West, P.O. Box 144870, Salt Lake City, Utah 84114-4870 on or before March 6, 2004.
