PARTIAL REGULATORY BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT IN CALIFORNIA

The three Army Corps of Engineers district offices in California (Los Angeles, Sacramento and San Francisco) have realigned a portion of their regulatory boundaries in California to simplify coordination and improve communication between major applicants and the Corps' Regulatory Branches. This change will take effect on the date of this Public Notice. It should be noted that this boundary adjustment does *not* change any of the regulations that govern the Corps' permit program.

The realignment is along county boundaries and affects the following counties (see the attached drawing): Modoc, Siskiyou, Glenn, Lake, Napa, Monterey, San Benito and San Luis Obispo. *All other counties in California are not affected.* The following table clarifies which Corps district administers the Regulatory program in the affected counties.

Other counties were not realigned by political boundaries because the existing drainage basin approach appears not to cause any noticeable issues in coordination between major applicants and the respective Corps districts.

All applicants in the affected counties should begin to apply for *new* permits (standard and nationwide permits) to the Corps district office based on the above table. All new jurisdictional determinations (wetlands and waters of the U.S.) will also be made by the appropriate Corps district office according to the above table. *Pending* applications for Corps permits in the affected counties will continue to be evaluated and processed by the Corps office that currently has your application.
