

General Regulations:

1. All California Department of Fish and Wildlife regulations apply. For further info, go to (<https://wildlife.ca.gov/>).
2. Bass limit: 12-inch total length minimum size limit and a five-fish daily bag limit.
3. Trout limit: No size limit and a five-fish daily bag limit.
4. Sunfish and Crappie: No size limit and a 25 fish daily bag limit (all species combined).
5. Taking carp by bow and arrow or spearfishing is permitted.
6. Hunting is permitted by shotgun, archery, and falconry only. Loaded firearms, ammunition, crossbows or other projectile devices are NOT allowed.
7. Target practice or use of clay targets is prohibited.
8. Eastman Lake is a non-lead ammunition area (California, CCR T14-250.1).
9. Weapons must be unloaded and cased or otherwise rendered inoperable while being transported to, from or between hunting and fishing sites.

All areas are patrolled by U.S. Army Corps of Engineer Rangers, Madera County Sheriff's Department, and California Department of Fish and Wildlife.
