

## General Regulations:

1. All California Department of Fish and Wildlife regulations apply. For further info, go to ([www.re4sec@wildlife.ca.gov](mailto:www.re4sec@wildlife.ca.gov)).
2. Special bass limit: Only one bass 22" or longer may be taken per day. All other bass must be released.
3. Trout limit: 5 per day, no size limit.
4. Sunfish and crappie: 25 per day (all species combined), no size limit.
5. Taking carp by bow and arrow or spearfishing is permitted.
6. Hunting is permitted by shotgun, archery, and falconry only. No handguns, rifles, air guns, slingshots or other projectile devices are allowed.
7. Target practice or use of clay targets is prohibited.
8. Eastman Lake is a non-lead ammunition area (California, CCR T14-250.1).
9. Weapons must be unloaded and cased or otherwise rendered inoperable while being transported or in the campground and/or other public areas.

All areas are patrolled by U.S. Army Corps of Engineer Rangers, Madera County Sheriff's Department, and California Department of Fish and Wildlife.
