DYE TESTING IN PROGRESS

Expected: Green Dye Test in Sacramento River - Old Town Sacramento Area

✅ **SAFETY INFORMATION - No Action Required**

Please Note: You may see temporary green coloring in the river water during testing. This is normal and expected. The dye will NOT harm people, fish, animals, or plants.



TESTING PERIOD: 29 OCTOBER – 7 NOVEMBER 2025

Dye may appear in the river anytime during this period

What's Happening

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, working with the City of Sacramento and CA Central Valley Flood Protection Board, is testing the stability of the floodwall in this area using non-toxic, biodegradable dye.

- We are assessing water movement between the river and soils behind the floodwall.
- This scheduled testing helps ensure long-term flood protection for our community.
- Results will inform future floodwall improvements. This work is authorized under Public Law 84-99, a federal program supporting flood risk management.
