We're Working to Lower Your Flood Risk

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Central Valley Flood Protection Board, California Department of Water Resources and the Sacramento Area Flood Control Agency are partnering to construct levee improvements in the area.

Construction on the Sacramento River East Levee, Contract 1 is scheduled to begin next spring. As part of prepartory work, the Corps of Engineers is conducting exploratory drilling to verify subsurface conditions prior to construction start.

As a result, Garcia Bend Park has been identified as the most appropriate location for staging and storage of materials. Crews will be using this area through the end of the year, and we expect this section to re-open before January 1, 2020.
