

Beach Stone Lakes Mitigation



- Approximately 24.2 acres of Riparian Woodland habitat will be created adjacent to the Sacramento River.
- Pre-planting activities will commence in October 2019.
- Planting is expected to be complete by December 2019.
- Five-year maintenance period will help ensure successful plant establishment.
- Mitigation plantings will include native tree, shrub, grass and forb species, including:
 - Boxelder, Coyote Brush, Mule Fat, Redbud, Oregon Ash, California Sycamore, Fremont Cottonwood, Valley Oak, California Rose, Red Willow, Arroyo Willow, Blue Elderberry, Spike Bentgrass, Blue Wild-rye, Slender Wheatgrass, Creeping Wild-rye, Meadow Barley, Purple Needle Grass, Common Yarrow, American Bird's Foot Trefoil, Mugwort, Red Maids, Purple Clarkia, California Poppy, Common Woolly Sunflower, Western Goldenrod, Common Gumplant, Miniature Lupine, Chick Lupine, Lacy Phacelia, Pacific Aster, Tomcat Clover.
