



American River Common Features 2016 American River Levees Monthly Update

May 2022

Welcome to the new American River newsletter

Years of effort to upgrade the levees along the Lower American River (LAR) are culminating in the installation of erosion protection measures.

The 2022 construction season will address the highest risk areas along the Lower American River adjacent to the River Park and Campus Commons neighborhoods.

Contract 1 (Site 2-1) is located on the left (southwest) bank of the American River from just upstream of the H Street Bridge near Sacramento State University downstream to Glenn Hall Park.

Contract 2 (Sites 2-2 & 2-3) are located on the right (northeast) bank of the American River from just upstream of Howe Avenue to the downstream end of the Campus Commons Golf Course. 2022 construction will be limited to Site 2-3 downstream of H Street.

Highlights (last 30+ days)

Contract 1

Limited vegetation clearing and elderberry transplanting was completed within the construction footprint and staging area in March. Contractor mobilization and site preparation began in April.

Contract 2 (Season 1)

Limited vegetation clearing and elderberry transplanting was completed within construction footprint at the campus commons golf course in March.

Looking Ahead (next 30+ days)

Current Activity - What can I expect?

Work hours (both contracts):

Monday-Saturday from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Sunday 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Contract 1

- Mobilization will complete in mid-May and excavation at paradise beach will begin by the end of the month.
- The majority of construction and haul traffic will access the Site 2-1 work area from Glenn Hall Park via Carlson Drive.
- Access to all facilities at Glenn Hall park and access to Paradise Beach will be maintained. Levee top access between Glenn Hall Park and H street will be closed throughout the construction period. Look for directional signage for alternate routes.

Contract 2 (Season 1)

- Mobilization will occur during May and excavation along the channel bank adjacent to the golf course will begin in June.

Caution: Construction exclusion fencing is provided for public safety. Please respect established exclusion zones for your own safety.

Question of the Month

Is Paradise Beach still open during construction? How can I access it?

Paradise Beach and the amenities at Glenn Hall Park such as the swimming pool, tennis courts, and soccer and baseball fields are all still open to the public. We've posted some directional signage to help navigate around the fenced off entry point for our construction vehicle traffic.

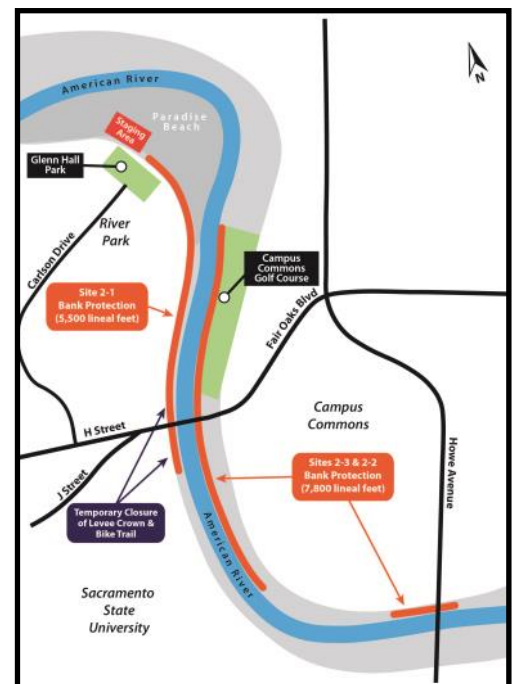
