We're Working to Lower Your Flood Risk

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Central Valley Flood Protection Board, California Department of Water Resources and Sacramento Area Flood Control Agency are partnering to improve the levee in the area.

Construction on the Sacramento River East Levee, Contract 2 is scheduled to begin in spring 2021. As part of preparatory work, the Corps of Engineers is conducting exploratory drilling to verify subsurface conditions prior to construction start.

During the period of April 20-29, 2020, the Corps of Engineers will be performing exploratory borings between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. The operation will not restrict access to residences within the area.

Schedule:

April 20-22: Clipper Way parallel to the levee. Three borings on the north side of the road, may reduce lanes and restrict parking access.

April 20-24: Levee crest parallel to Clipper Way. The levee crest will not be accssible for safety reasons.

April 27-29: Levee crest bike trail north of Broadway. Flaggers will be present to allow passage through work areas.
