


Success Dam Reservoir Historic Water Levels (2003-2014)

Glossary:

Acre-foot - the volume of water required to fill one acre to a depth of one foot. (Approx. 325,850 gallons)

Authorized gross pool - the maximum water storage capacity of the reservoir behind Success Dam.

Restricted pool - a limitation on reservoir water storage implemented in late 2006 by the Corps of Engineers to minimize catastrophic flood risk to the public while it studied the dam's susceptibility to overtopping and seepage.

* The Corps allows occasional short deviations above the restricted elevation to reasonably maximize the amount of water provided to water users. Inspection and monitoring programs are increased during these short time periods to ensure public safety.
