#### **Installation Overview - Hill Air Force Base**

> Hill Air Force Base (AFB) is comprised of over 6,000 acres that sits roughly 25 miles north of Salt Lake City, Utah. Currently, the base is occupied by the Ogden Air Logistics Complex, the 75th Air Base Wing, the 388th Fighter Wing, the 419th Fighter Wing and over 40 other tenant organizations. In addition to its units, the base is home to major components of the Nation's ground based nuclear weapons program (Sentinel - Ground Based Strategic Deterrent [GBSD]).

> Hill AFB plays a vital role in maintaining a fighting force to carry out our country's national security strategy, supporting our country's military readiness, and bolstering our capacity to deter foreign aggression.
