

Former Titan 1-A Missile Facility

- Formerly used Defense Site (FUDS)
- Oversee work by USACE on behalf of DoD
- Review reported soil vapor and groundwater contamination monitoring
- Review and provide comments on Technical Documents
 - Draft Remedial Investigation (RI) Sept 2024
 - Draft Treatability Study Quality Assurance Protection Plan Oct 2024
 - Final RI Nov/Dec 2024
 - Draft Feasibility Study (FS) 2025
 - Proposed Remedial Design/Remedial Action 2027

Former Placer County Gun Ranges

- Former Pistol Range and Skeet Range Closed in 1999
- Have impacted surface soils on-site with lead shot and clay pigeon debris (other related contamination)
- Remedial Action Plan (RAP) completed in 2023
- Work Plan forthcoming Fall 2024
- Remedial Action to begin 2025

Hidden Hills Development

- Management required to develop near hazardous waste site.
- Portions of deep utilities run through known contamination areas and require management and mitigation.
- Land use covenants (LUCs) in place to allow residential and recreational development that is protective of human health.
- Priorities
 - Do not allow existing contamination to migrate as result of development.
 - Be protective of future land use scenarios.
 - Development does not hinder future Titan 1A restoration activities.

Who Pays?

- Private Site Cleanup is a Cost Recovery Program
- Responsible and/or impacted parties pay for our oversight
 - Titan 1-A Oversight: Department of Defense
 - Shooting Range Oversight: Placer County
 - Hidden Hills Development Oversight: Century Communities

The facility was constructed in 1961 and operated from 1962 to 1965 by the U.S. Air Force. It consists of an underground intercontinental ballistic missile launch control facility. Domestic wastewater was pumped to a septic tank followed by an oxidation pond before discharging to the ground surface. Trichloroethene (TCE) was used to clean oxygen lines. Groundwater has been impacted by TCE which annears to have originated in the area of the current County Cornoration Yard.
