- CO: Western Slope


# Organization

- 4 branches (CA North, CA South, NV-UT, and CO West), based primarily on political boundaries, and an Enforcement Unit
- Staff of 45 operating out of 7 offices

## Funding

- General Regulatory Funds
  - Annual Energy and Water Appropriation
  - Distributed by Corps HQ among 8 Division and 38 District offices
- Section 214 of Water Resources Development Act
  - Allows non-federal public entities to provide funds to Regulatory to expedite permit review for public projects
  - Authority expires Dec 2017





# **Program Performance FY13**

#### Permitting

- Total permits issued = 1,329
  - 21 Standard Permits
  - 20 Letters of Permission
  - 1,025 Nationwide Permit Verifications
  - 263 Regional and Programmatic General Permit Verifications
- Compare to FY12 = 2,305
- 305 permit applications withdrawn

#### Enforcement

- Resolved 18 of 51 (35%) cases of permit non-compliance
- Resolved 48 of 143 (33%) cases of unauthorized activities
- Compare to FY12: case number about the same; increase in resolution rate

#### Jurisdiction Determinations


- Total JDs = 1,064
  - 119 Approved JDs
  - 567 Preliminary JDs
  - 378 No JD required or withdrawn

#### National Performance Measures

- Met/exceeded all metrics
- FY12: Decreases in 6/8 categories
