# Sacramento District Regulatory Division

## ▪ Area of Responsibility

- ▶ CA Central Valley and Sierra Nevada, NV, UT, and CO Western Slope
- ▶ Highly diverse area climatically, topographically, politically
- ▶ Challenges: endangered species, cultural resources, tribal interests, public interest

## ▪ Organization

- ▶ 61 people in 7 offices across four states
- ▶ Report directly to District Commander

## ▪ Execution

- ▶ About 1000 permit decisions, 700 JDs, 50 resolved violations/yr
- ▶ Meet/exceed 7/8 national performance measures

## ▪ Funding

- ▶ General Regulatory Functions
- ▶ Section 214 of Water Resources Development Act of 2000, as amended

## ▪ National

- ▶ Corps' Scope for ESA Consultation

## ▪ Regional/State

- ▶ Compliance with NHPA 106 and CA SHPO
- ▶ CA WQCB Proposed Procedures for Discharges of Dredged or Fill Material into Waters of the State
- ▶ Developing regional general permit for restoration projects with Sustainable Conservation

## ▪ Local

- ▶ 404 Permit Strategies Aligned with Proposed HCPs
- ▶ Developing guidance for approving advance compensatory mitigation
