▪ Area of Responsibility

- ▶ CA Central Valley and Sierra Nevada, NV, UT, and CO Western Slope
- ▶ Highly diverse area climatically, topographically, politically
- ▶ Challenges: endangered species, cultural resources, tribal interests, public interest

▪ Organization

- ▶ 62 people in 7 offices across four states
- ▶ Report directly to District Commander

▪ Execution


- ▶ About 1000 permit decisions, 700 JDs, 50 resolved violations/yr
- ▶ Meet/exceed national performance measures

- ▶ General Regulatory Functions (GRF)
