# Sacramento District Regulatory Division

## ■ Area of Responsibility

- ▶ CA Central Valley and Sierra Nevada, NV, UT, and CO Western Slope
- ▶ Highly diverse area climatically, topographically, politically
- ▶ Challenges: endangered species, cultural resources, public interest

## ■ Organization

- ▶ 61 people in 7 offices across four states
- ▶ Report directly to District Commander

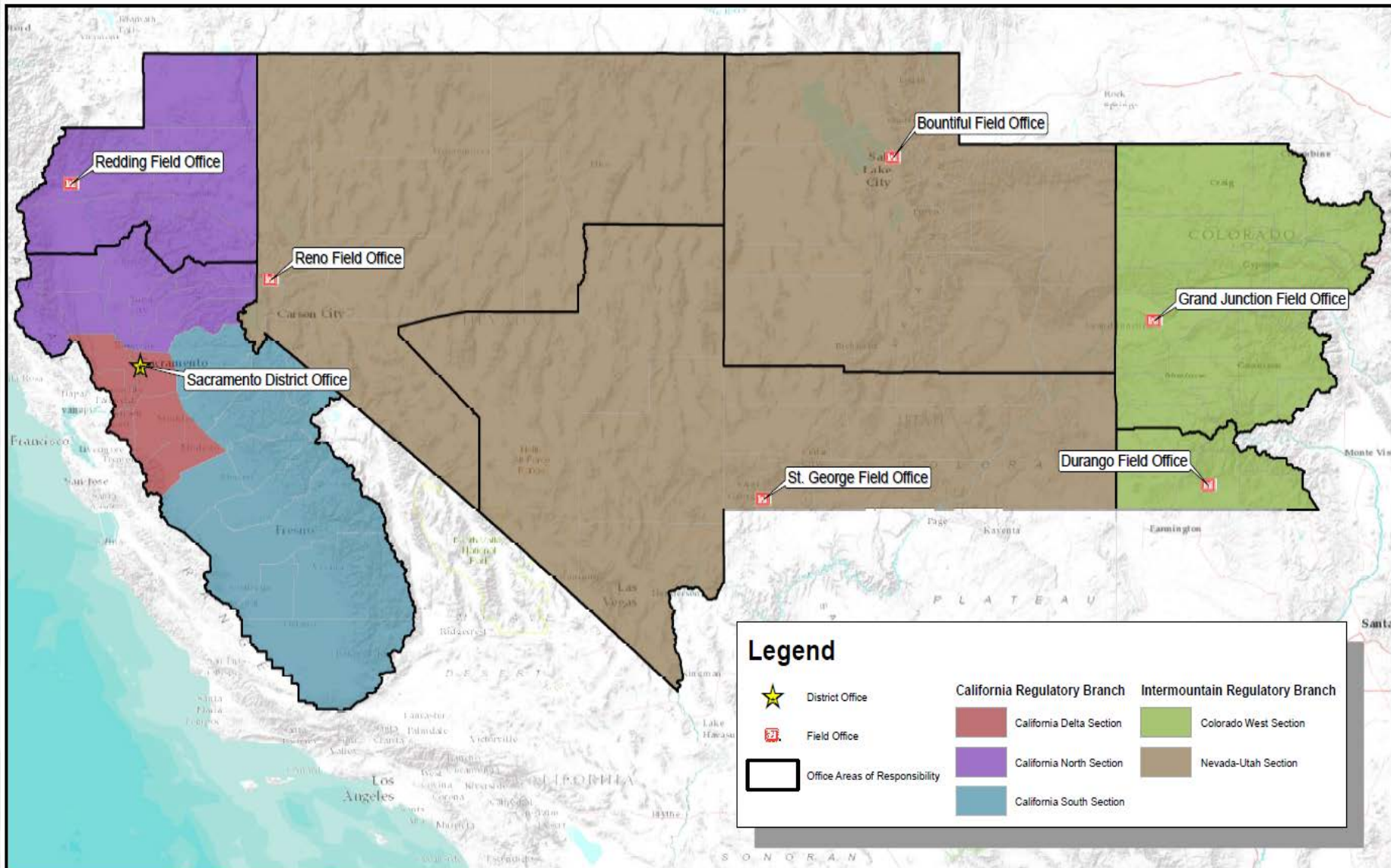
## ■ Execution

- ▶ 1000 permit decisions (95% under GP)
- ▶ 500 jurisdictional determinations
- ▶ 50 violations resolved

## ■ Funding

- ▶ General Regulatory Functions (GRF)
- ▶ Section 214 of Water Resources Development Act of 2000
