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Nationwide Permits Pre-Construction Notification (PCN) Form

- Streamlined permitting process (no PN issued, no off-site alternatives analysis)
- Requires (almost) all the information up front that is necessary to evaluate and verify that the project fits the NWP.





Contents of PCN – General Condition 32(b) Made in Writing

- 1. Name, address, and telephone numbers of prospective permittee
- 2. Location of the proposed project





- 3. Project Description sufficient detail to determine minimal adverse effects and need for compensatory mitigation
 - a) Project purpose;
 - b) Direct and indirect impacts;
 - Amount of loss of waters of the US in acres or linear feet;
 - d) Other NWP authorizations or IP for any part of project or related activity;
 - e) Sketches (e.g. conceptual plan) illustrative
 description of the proposed activity



4. Delineation of Waters

- a) Wetlands and other waters
- b) Prepared in accordance with "current method..."
- c) May request Corps to complete the delineation, however there "may be a delay..."







5. Mitigation Statement

- a) If loss of greater than 1/10-acre:
- b) How impacts to waters of the US are to be compensated for; or
- c) Why adverse effects are minimal and why compensatory mitigation should not be required for the proposed impacts.
- SPK's Regional Conditions for Utah offer more insight on mitigation info needs- more on that to come.



6. Federally-listed species or Critical Habitat

- a) Non-federal applicants: names of listed species
- b) Federal applicants must provide documentation demonstrating compliance with ESA Sec 7 (BO or other FWS concurrence)

7. Historic Properties

- a) Provide cultural resource report with literature search and onsite assessment
- b) Federal applicants must provide documentation demonstrating compliance with Sec 106 of NHPA

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On March 18, 2012, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' South Pacific Division approved 24 regional conditions for the 2012 Nationwide Permits (NVPP) in Utah, within the Sacramento District. This checklist is intended to assist applicants with completing the South Pacific Division Pre-Construction Notification Checklist and to ensure compliance with the regional conditions. This checklist does not include the full text of each regional condition.

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Regional Conditions

 a) Written statement describing avoidance and minimization of temporary and permanent impacts.
 Note: more specific than NWP GC 31(b)(5): Mitigation Statement

b) Plan view and cross-section view

- i. Location, size, and dimension of activity
- ii. Location of delineated waters
- iii. Amount (cubic yards) and area (acres) of fill
- iv. Ordinary high water mark/high tide line
- c) Pre-project color photographs



Regional Conditions

5. Description of the proposed temporary fill

- a) Type and amount of material;
- b) The area proposed to be impacted; and
- Proposed plan for restoration of temporary fill including re-vegetation plan;
- d) Reason why avoidance of temporary impacts is not practicable





Regional Conditions

21. Requests to waive the 300 linear foot limitation

- A narrative description of the stream volume and duration of flow; length, width, and depth; a description of the adjacent vegetation community; a statement regarding the wetland status of the adjacent areas; surrounding land use; water quality; cumulative impacts in the watershed; any other relevant information
- b) Analysis of impacts as described in #1
- c) Measures to avoid and minimize losses to waters of the US
- d) A compensatory mitigation plan





Incomplete



- NWP Permittee notified, Corps requests additional information within <u>30 days</u> of receipt of the PCN.
 - a) Specify the information needed to make the PCN Complete
 - b) "General Rule" request additional information only once





Tips for timely processing

- Do your best to submit a complete application
 - Include everything necessary to process (delineation, alternatives, ESA, NHPA, mitigation plan, etc.)
- Use a template ours, yours
- Get us involved early!
- When in doubt, refer to regs or *call us*






Common Missing Items

- Clear, concise project map showing waters of the US and project impacts
- Section 106 reports, T&E reports
- Statement of avoidance & minimization
- Regional conditions checklist

*Bottom line- all items get overlooked now and then, so just be thorough!
