Sacramento District (SPK) Regulatory Division

■ Area of Responsibility

- ▶ CA Central Valley and Sierra Nevada, NV, UT, and CO Western Slope
- ▶ Highly diverse area climatically, topographically, politically
- ▶ Challenges: endangered species, cult. resources, Tribes, public interest

■ Organization

- ▶ 50 people in 6 offices across four states
- ▶ Report directly to District Commander

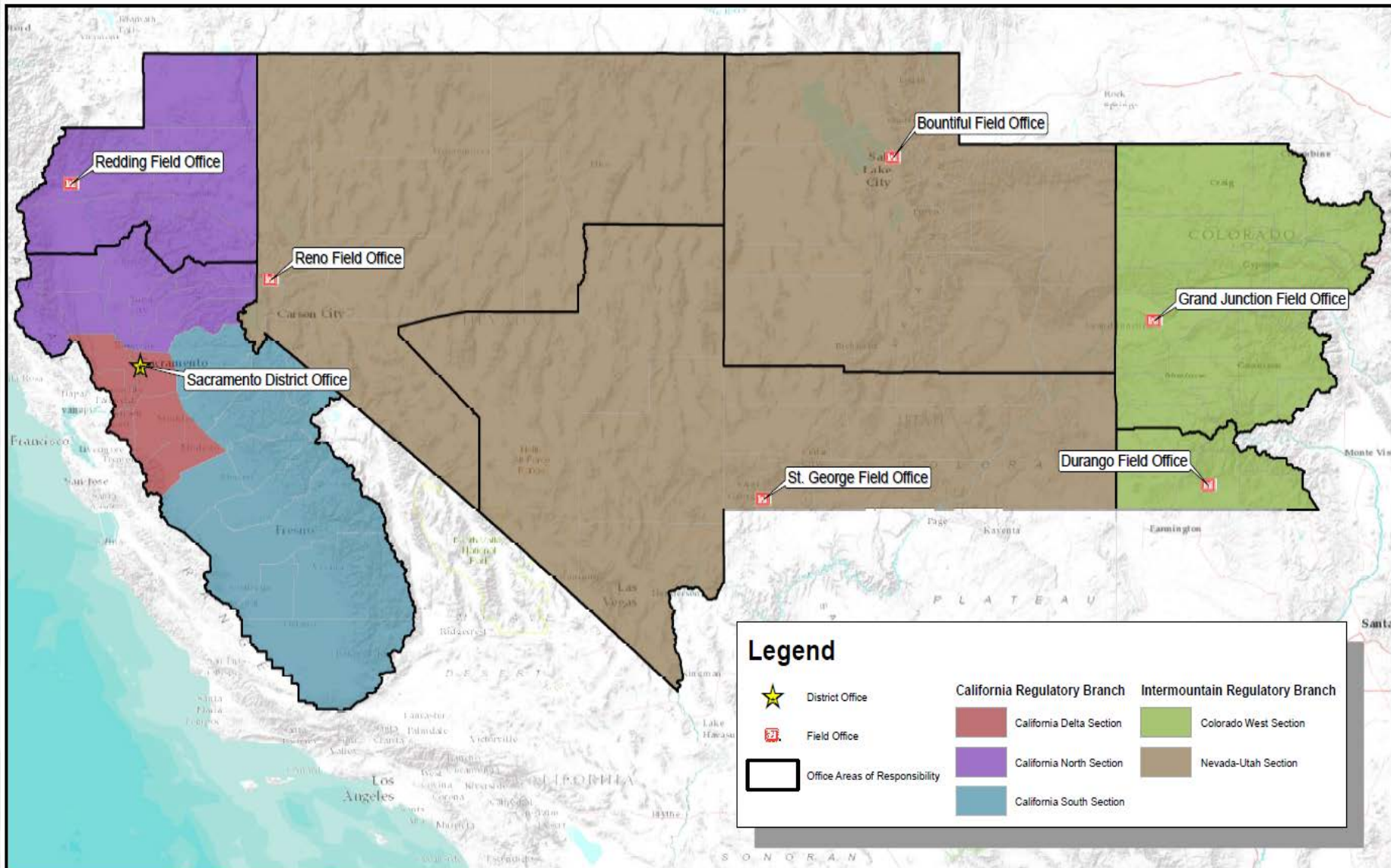
■ Execution

- ▶ 800-1000 permit decisions (95% by General Permit)
- ▶ 500 jurisdictional determinations
- ▶ 50 violations resolved

■ Funding

- ▶ General Regulatory Functions (GRF)
- ▶ Section 214 of Water Resources Development Act of 2000

■ National

- ▶ Definition of Waters of the United States
 - 2015 Clean Water Rule Litigation
 - New Definition – Steps 1 (Rescind 2015 CWR) and 2 (Replace 2015 CWR)
- ▶ Proposed changes to Compensatory Mitigation regulations
- ▶ Proposed 2020 Nationwide Permits
- ▶ Regulatory Program and 408 Program Synchronization
- ▶ Policy/guidance on credit releases, climate change, permits for sponsors implementing Corps Civil Works project

■ Regional/State

- ▶ Proposed NHPA 106 Programmatic Agreement with CA SHPO
- ▶ Proposed Procedures for Discharges of Dredged or Fill Material into Waters of the State by CA Water Resources Control Board

■ Local

- ▶ Permit strategies aligned with regional habitat conservation plans
