This workshop will focus on the Mitigation Rule, including an update on the mitigation banking program, an overview of the mitigation rule at 33 C.F.R. 332, and an introduction to the Regulatory In-Lieu Fee and Bank Information Tracking System (RIBITS). Updates will include an overview of mitigation practices, such as avoidance and minimization prior to compensatory mitigation, as well as ways to use RIBITS to inform compensatory mitigation planning. The workshop will also cover the current procedures for advance mitigation proposals.

The Sacramento District holds the Regulatory Program Workshop in Sacramento quarterly to provide the public with information about Corps' permit requirements and updates on program execution in the Sacramento District. The workshop is open to interested parties including the regulated public, consultants, environmental organizations, and Federal, state and local agencies. The July 31, 2020, workshop will be held via webinar, with details to be provided at a later day. Similar workshops are held less frequently in other locations in the Sacramento District's area of responsibility, including Bountiful, Utah and Grand Junction, Colorado.
