DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED NATIONWIDE PERMIT ACTIVITY (see instructions) The proposed project would fill in approximately 0.12 acre of perennial stream, 0.03 acre of riparian wetland, and 0.1 acre of adjacent seasonal wetlands to construct a 40 home subdivision that would include streets, curbs, gutters, sidewalks, driveways, and utilities. The 2021 Matthew's Residential Development plans are attached and show all impacts and designs.

20. DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED MITIGATION MEASURES (see instructions) The proposed project would avoid 0.4 acre of seasonal wetland and has been designed to minimize and avoid impacts to aquatic resources to the maximum extent possible. Best Management Practices would include fencing off avoided aquatic resources with a 50 foot buffer and having a qualified biologist on-site to conduct a worker environmental brief and ensure no federally listed species are within the action area.

PURPOSE OF NATIONWIDE PERMIT ACTIVITY (*Describe the reason or purpose of the project, see instructions*) The purpose of the proposed project is to provide more affordable housing within Tehama County that currently has a housing shortage. Ground breaking disturbance is anticipated to begin in May of 2022.

The 2017 Pre-construction Form would not be necessary.

The mitigation proposed for Matthew's Residential Development is use of the In-Lieu-Fee (National Fish and Wildlife Foundation) program.
We would purchase 0.24 credits of Northwest Sacramento River Aquatic Resource for stream impacts and 0.26 credits of unallocated

advanced credits for wetland impacts. Explain if it deviates from the hierarchy of the 2008 Mitigation rule.


18 U.S.C. Section 1001 provides that: Whoever, in any manner within the jurisdiction of any department or agency of the United States knowingly and willfully falsifies, conceals, or covers up any trick, scheme, or disguises a material fact or makes any false, fictitious or fraudulent statements or representations or makes or uses any false writing or document knowing same to contain any false, fictitious or fraudulent statements or entry, shall be fined not more than \$10,000 or imprisoned not more than five years or both.

33 CFR 325.1(d)(8) States:

(8) *Signature on application.* The application must be signed by the person who desires to undertake the proposed activity (*i.e.*, the applicant) or by a duly authorized agent. When the applicant is represented by an agent, that information will be included in the space provided on the application or by a separate written statement. The signature of the applicant or the agent will be an affirmation that the applicant possesses or will possess the requisite property interest to undertake the activity proposed in the application, except where the lands are under the control of the Corps of Engineers, in which cases the district engineer will coordinate the transfer of the real estate and the permit action. An application may include the activity of more than one owner provided the character of the activity of each owner is similar and in the same general area and each owner submits a statement designating the same agent.
