Area of Responsibility

- CA Central Valley and Sierra Nevada, NV, and UT
- Highly diverse area climatically, topographically, politically
- Challenges: endangered species, cultural resources, Tribes, public interest

Execution

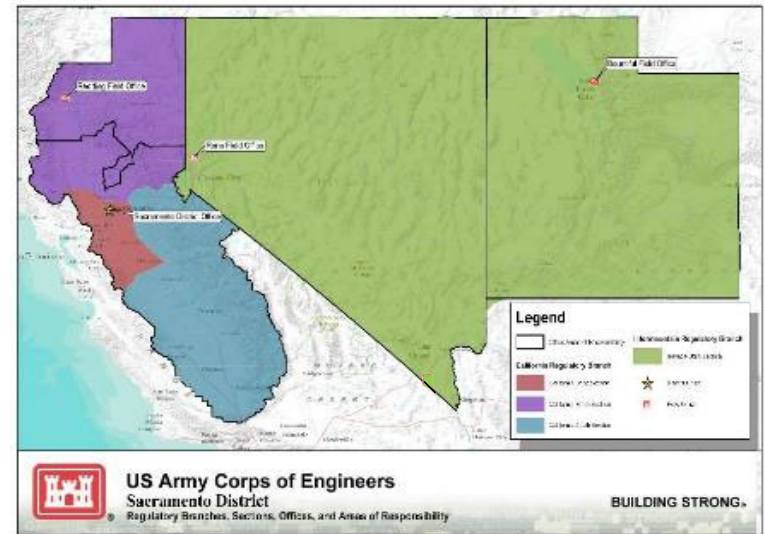
- 700 permit decisions (95% by General Permit)
- 300 jurisdictional determinations
- 15 enforcement actions resolved

Organization

- 53 people in 4 offices across 3 states
- Expertise in jurisdiction and mitigation banking

- Bipartisan Infrastructure Law
