# OVERVIEW



## Area of Responsibility

- States of UT and NV; CA Central Valley and Sierra Nevada
- Highly diverse topographically, hydrologically, biologically, politically
- Challenges: ESA, cultural resources, Tribes, public interest

## Organization

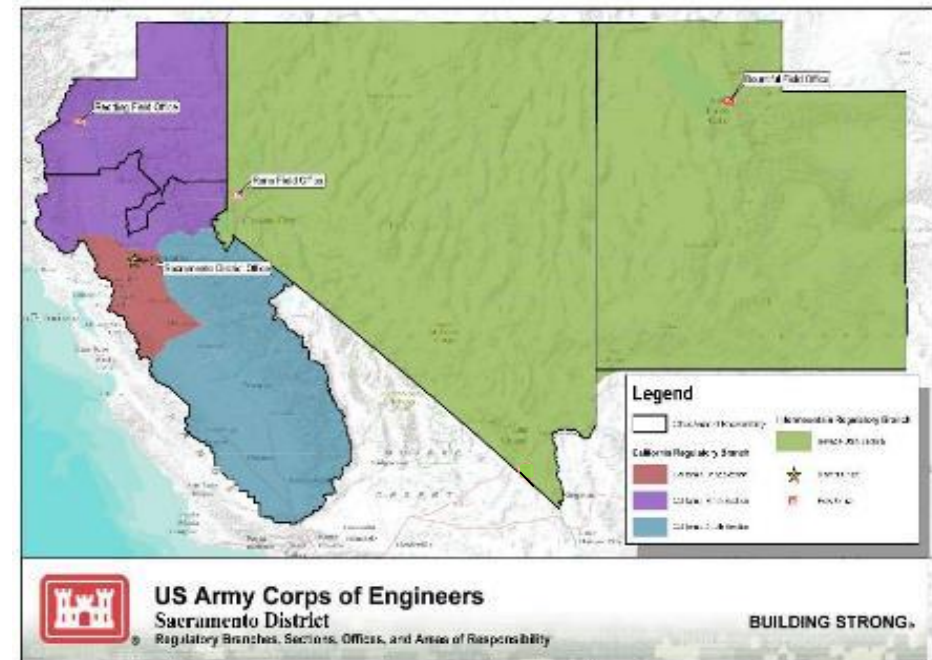
- 59 people in 4 offices
- Expertise: jurisdiction, master-planned projects, mitigation banking

## Funding

- General Regulatory Functions (annual appropriation)
- Section 214 of Water Resources Development Act
- Bipartisan Infrastructure Law

## Execution

- 800 permit decisions (95% by General Permit)
- 300 jurisdictional determinations
- 20 enforcement actions resolved
