# OVERVIEW



## Area of Responsibility

- CA Central Valley and Sierra Nevada and States of NV and UT
- Highly diverse (climate, topography, political views, etc.)
- Challenges: endangered species, cultural resources, Tribes, public interest

## Execution

- 850 permit decisions (93% by General Permit)
- 400 jurisdictional determinations and aquatic resource delineation verifications
- 20 enforcement actions resolved

## Organization

- 56 people in 4 offices
- Expertise in jurisdiction, master-planned communities, and mitigation banking

## Funding

- General Regulatory Functions (annual appropriation in Energy & Water)
- Section 214 of Water Resources Development Act of 2000, as amended
- Bipartisan Infrastructure Law
