OVERVIEW



Area of Responsibility

- CA Central Valley and Sierra Nevada and States of NV and UT
- Highly diverse area climatically, topographically, politically
- Challenges: endangered species, cultural resources, Tribes, public interest

Execution

- 750-1000 permit decisions (>92% by General Permit)
- 300-400 jurisdictional determinations
- 20-30 enforcement actions (permit non-compliance and unauthorized fills) resolved

Organization

- 56 people in 4 offices
- Expertise in jurisdiction, mitigation banking, large-scale development

Funding

- General Regulatory Functions (annual appropriation under Energy & Water)
- Section 214 of Water Resources Development Act of 2000, as amended
- Bipartisan Infrastructure Law
