OVERVIEW



Area of Responsibility

- CA Central Valley and Sierra Nevada and States of NV and UT
- Highly diverse area climatically, topographically, politically
- Challenges: endangered species, cultural resources, Tribes, public interest

Execution

- 780 permit decisions; >95% by General Permit
- 280 jurisdictional determinations
- 28 enforcement actions resolved

Organization

- 55 people in 4 offices (Sacramento, Redding, Reno, Bountiful)
- Expertise in jurisdiction, mitigation banking, large-scale development/NEPA

Funding

- General Regulatory Functions (annual appropriation under Energy & Water)
- Bipartisan Infrastructure Law
- Section 214 of Water Resources Development Act of 2000, as amended
