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C. Additional comments to support AJD: The nearest potential (a)(1) - (a)(3) water is Truckee River, a perennial stream, located approximately 200 feet outside of the study area. The intervening area between the Truckee River and the non-adjacent wetland is upland. There is an elevated dirt road, running east to west, that runs along the property line and acts as a barrier between the non-adjacent wetland and adjacent wetlands along Truckee River. There is no culvert or other structure that would allow a hydrologic surface water connection to occur between the non-adjacent wetland and Truckee River in a typical year.

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
