C. Additional comments to support AJD: There is one ditch in the project area which is labelled as segments 1 through 4. Historical topographical maps from 1941 show a remnant ditch segment - North Fork Ditch and no other previous waters. Modern maps show the current ditch segments occurring along topographic lines and not intersecting across topography nor following any natural channels or depressions. Based on this information, we have determined that the ditch neither relocates a tributary, is constructed in a tributary, or is constructed in an adjacent wetland; therefore, this features is excluded under paragraph (b)(5) of the NWPR.
