MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Traditional Navigable Water, Navigable In-Fact Determination for Panguitch Lake in Garfield County, Utah (ID SPK-2009-00779)

1. The Corps has completed a review of Panguitch Lake to determine its eligibility as a navigable-in-fact waterway.
2. This determination is made in accordance to Appendix D of the Rapanos Guidance
3. Panguitch Lake is a natural lake that has been expanded to serve as a reservoir. The 1,248-acre lake is a popular destination location in a heavily traveled tourist area with three national parks and one national monument. The lake has two public boat ramps, several campgrounds and commercial lodges. Boat rentals are available ranging from \$40 to \$140 per day depending on the type of boat rented. The lake offers fishing, boating, and several other outdoor opportunities to the general public. The attached map indicates the location of the reservoir.
